

## PROM Activities

- PROM logo on boutonniere and corsage boxes from local florist
- Incorporate into other clubs and events
- Mock accident and funeral during the week before Prom
- Group discussion of safe driving during homeroom activities
- Decorate homeroom doors – pass out trinkets for prizes
- Use the Teen Driving Statistics for a trivia game
- Get the press involved and you can reach more of the community!
- Read facts in your announcements over intercom system
- Draw up a pledge agreement and have students sign them
- Ask local newspaper display the signatures of the pledges
- Ask your coroner to speak
- Automated phone calls to parents of all students attending prom
- Hold an informational community night
- Ask businesses if you can post posters
- Play traffic games in gym class and pass out materials as prizes
- Have younger students write cards wishing prom-goers a fun but safe night and remind the prom-goers how much they look up to them.
- Organize a “Dead Day” where students are pulled randomly out of class and pronounced as “dead”, when they return to class they must be silent the rest of the day.
- Hand out a material provided each day leading up to your school’s prom event.
- Ask your local police department to assist your efforts!
- Pass out materials as students receive their Prom tickets
- Teachers can wear the previous year’s PROM shirts!
- Show PSAs during lunch hour
- Have students write their good choices and display on banner
- Pass out materials as they leave the dance
- Invite a motivational speaker to present pre-prom
- Use breathalyzer before students can gain admittance to Prom...
- Conduct a “Safe Driving Quiz” that teachers can put together from the facts sheet
- Put up “Please Return on Monday” by putting up one word on Monday, the next on Tuesday... Until Please Return on Monday is posted all over the school by Friday.
- Utilize your school marquee to display a safe driving message
- Have students write and perform a play describing the emotions of losing a peer to a fatal crash after Prom
